

Monetary Policy 2080/81

HAN Submitted Memo to NRB Governor

President Mr. Binayak Shah Presented current business trend of Hotel industry and submitted expectations of Hotel industry from the monetary policy at a interaction program organized by Nepal Rastra Bank and chaired and moderated by Governor Mr. Maha Prasad Adhikari himself. Major points presented in HAN Memo. Number of tourist arrival is in rise but has utilized only about 25% of the



capacity of the sector. It is due to only limited infrastructure development for wider connectivity such as airports, highway and expansion of new hotels even during Covid time. This means hotels are operating in losses and need policy intervention such as restructuring and refinancing of credit, repayment policy reforms in fixation of basic rate, interest rate and introduction of provisions to pay interest and capital in several installments. This is urgent need to declare hotel/tourism sector as National Priority Industry and introduce supportive policies to keep the industry alive. HAN President Mr. Shah presented Hotels prospective at similar interaction programs organized by Management Association of Nepal and USAID.

KMC announced 30% **concession on Hotel Property Tax**

Kathmandu Metropolitan City (KMC) announced 30% discount on Property Tax on hotels/resorts for fiscal year 2080-081. HAN appreciates decision of KMC for considering Hotel Industry plea to lower the taxes as the sector is still facing financial and operational loses during Covid. Additional 10% discount is available to tax payers who pays before end of Push 2080.

One Million tourists in 2023, Special Tourism Year in 2025 and Tourism Decade 2023-2032

Hotel Association Nepal and its Chapters organized Sales mission in different countries to help to achieve the target of one million tourist arrivals in the Tourism Decade beginning year 2023 announced by the government. Likewise, Government has announced 2025 as the special tourism year, Hotel Association Nepal started homework in close coordination with government to make it successful and meaningful.

E-learning Video on Hospitality

HAN held a discussion meeting with Education Committee in presence of President Mr Binayak Shah. The detailed modality of work and process flow was briefed by the proponent Katha Nepal and work in progressing well.

The motif of the project is to develop and produce a series of e-learning video resources focused on topics related to the hospitality industry soft skill. This platform will serve the purpose to provide standard information, first hand knowledge and soft skills required to everyone in hotel industry.

Basically, this will educate the hotel staffs, management, students and trainers to explore basics of hospitality, directly supporting them to standardize and upgrade the existing level.

HAN met with Spokesperson of Labor Ministry



HAN team led by president Mr Binayak Shah met with spokesperson and convenor of 'Minimum Wages Fixation Committee' Mr Dundu Raj Ghimire at his chamber and submitted hoteliers standpoint as the salary fixation decision draws nearer. Mr Shah presenting facts and figures demanded the government to acknowledge the hotel industry's concerns and urged to make a separate hotel sector's provision to resolve them specifically.
